



Tullamore Women's Junior Scratch Cup

Current Handicap Index 5.7 – 17.9

Regulations and Conditions of Competition

1. The organizing committee, which shall consist of officials appointed by Tullamore Golf Club, shall be responsible for the organization and management of the competition and its decision will be final on all matters relating thereto including acceptance of entries.
 2. Entries shall be limited to 92 competitors with the lowest exact handicap. There shall be a ballot, if necessary, for the final place(s).
 3. A waiting list of the next lowest 12 players will be used in the event of withdrawals. Any entrant whose application is unsuccessful will have her entry fee refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded for those who withdraw after the draw is published.
 4. The competition shall consist of 27 holes stroke played over one day.
 5. The draw for the 1st and 2nd rounds will be published on the website www.tullamoregolfclub.ie on Tuesday 29th August 2023.
 6. In order to be eligible to compete, a player must have a current Handicap Index no lower than 5.7. Competitors whose handicap has risen above the maximum will have to play off maximum handicap index of 17.9 to win a prize.
 7. Each competitor must be of amateur status as defined by the R & A Rules Limited, the holder of an official WHS handicap and member of an affiliated club.
 8. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A and in accordance with local rules of Tullamore Golf Club.
 9. In the event of a tie or ties the decision will be based on the score over the last 9 holes, then the first 18 holes, then on the last 9-6-3-2-1. If still tied decide on the last 3-6-7-8 or 9 of the 1st 9 holes. If still tied decision will be made by lot.
 10. Use of Golf Buggies is discouraged. If a competitor requires a golf buggy they must be in possession of a certificate of disability..
 11. Caddies are permitted. A competitor is prohibited from engaging a golf professional or assistant professional to serve as her caddie during the stipulated round.
 12. Competitors must register 30 minutes before tee time.
 13. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) the player is in breach of Rules for which the penalty under Rule 4.3 will be applied.,
 14. The Gross winner will be presented with the Junior Scratch Cup.
