LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18 - 2)

Player's Mobile Number

Outside any fence, bank, ditch or drain bounding the course and, on or over the line defined by white stakes. The practice putting green at the clubhouse, (including flower beds), clubhouse and car park enclosure.

2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17-1d)

Penalty areas are marked by; a) yellow stakes/lines b) red stakes/lines

3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16-1) (Including Immovable Obstructions)

Starter's hut, seats (excluding seat and shelter at 18th green), direction posts, sprinkler heads, artificial hole covers on putting greens, manhole covers, bells and posts, water taps, distance marker discs, litter bins and young staked trees, wooden steps on tee boxes, roads and paths with artificial surfaces (see 5 below) and buoys and their supporting stakes. Trees with tubing and/or netting are not staked trees.

4. ARTIFICIAL HOLE COVERS ON PUTTING GREENS

If a ball lies on the green and an artificial hole cover on the green intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole - relief may be obtained, without penalty, by lifting and placing the ball at the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole, which may be off the green.

5. INTEGRAL PART OF THE COURSE

The following are an integral part of the course:

- The seat and shelter at the 18th green.
- The toilets to the left of the 13th hole and their surroundings, including the path at the entrance. Planting on the right of the lake at the 5th hole.

Encroachment onto greens under construction to retrieve a ball is prohibited.

The **DEFIBRILLATOR** is located in the clubhouse beside the bar. Contact 057 9321439 if required urgently.
